Leaflets & Publicity

We've just taken delivery of a new batch of the 4 page leaflet, postcard and invitation postcard along with the hessian bags we used for goodie bags at the conference. If you would like any please just drop me an email. On the subject of leaflets we've created two new:

- 1) Focussing on why it is important that people join WiRE – sometimes it is not clear in the glossy ones
- 2) Rules of the house! There has been some discussion recently on the Facebook Leaders Group about people not turning up, MLM behaviour (most are great but some have been known to overstep the mark), use of data and getting involved – it never harms to remind people how to network.

Website

Feedback is really positive, fresher, much easier to use and the automatic reminders to re-join seem to be working!

We are looking to implement more functions and **really need your feedback**. These are mostly focussed on events – we want to make it as easy as possible; it's great for SEO, people can find you and it gives people a sense of the reach WiRE has nationally:

- 1) Online booking of events with payments going directly/immediately to the network leader or group bank account (a sort of WiRE Eventbrite). The only way to do this is by using Paypal as the payment mechanism. This is easy to set up and is free to the delegate but charges are 3.4% + 20p per transaction which means on a £10 payment you will receive £9.46. The positives are that if people pay in advance they are more likely to show, the payment is immediate, it looks professional and is easily transferrable.
- 2) Download spreadsheet of current members in your area directly from the website. Theoretically simple but since many attendees cross county boundaries the only sensible way to do it is by region (west mids, east, wales etc.) which means you may have lots of irrelevant data to filter through. Also we will have to ask for a disclaimer regarding use of data to be signed
- 3) Autofill of venue and times when adding events – basically if you always use the same venue at the same time, when you are adding events all you will need to do is add the date and the content/agenda
- 4) Option to add an extra page/post to your network page to add additional information (this is very simple so we will do it anyway, useful for newsletters, minutes etc.)

None of these are written in stone and we won't go ahead if you think they are unnecessary. Please email me fiona@wireuk.org with your thoughts.
